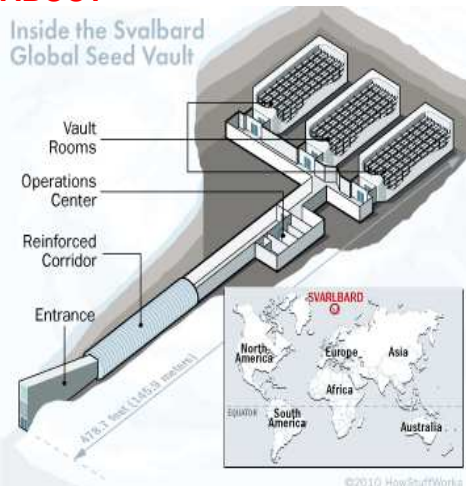
- It aims to **prevent distress sale** by farmers.
- e-Kisan Upaj Nidhi' initiative will ease the farmers' **warehousing logistics** with the help of technology and aid the farmers in **receiving fair prices** for their produce.
- Its simplified digital process can ease **the procedure of farmers' storage at any registered WDRA warehouse** for a period of 6 months at 7% interest per annum.

### 2. SVALBARD GLOBAL SEED VAULT

Svalbard Global Seed Vault got seeds from more new contributors than ever before.

#### ABOUT



- The Svalbard Global Seed Vault is situated in **permafrost caverns on an island** located within the **European mainland and the North Pole**.
- It is built to **preserve global crops** from extinction.
- The facility was established 16 years ago through a partnership between the **Nordic Genetic Resource Center, the Norwegian Ministry of Agriculture and Food and the Crop Trust**.
- It was designed to store over 2 billion seeds and guarantee their availability for future generations.
- It houses over 930,000 varieties of food crops.
- Acting as a **massive safety deposit box**, it contains the world's largest collection of agricultural biodiversity.

- Svalbard is one of the **most remote places** on Earth, located **far north** where commercial airlines reach their limits.

### 3. INDIA'S FIRST INTEGRATED OIL PALM PROCESSING UNIT BY 3F OIL PALM

India's first integrated oil palm processing unit by 3F Oil Palm started its commercial operations.

It is widely used edible vegetable oil derived from the fruit of the oil palm tree. Around 90% of the world's oil palm trees are grown on a few islands in Malaysia and Indonesia

#### Palm Oil

India is the world's largest palm oil importer & second largest consumer of palm oil

Indonesia and Malaysia are the two main exporters of palm oil to India at 61% and 32% respectively in 2020

### NATIONAL MISSION ON EDIBLE OILS – OIL PALM (NMEO-OP)



- Centrally sponsored scheme launched August 2021. Scheme offers **financial subsidies to farmers** for various activities related to **oil palm cultivation**.
- Targets to increase area of oil palm to 10 lakh hectares from 3.5 lakh ha during 2019-20 by 2025-26.
- Under NMEO-OP the cost will be shared as **60:40 between the Central and the State Government** for General states and **90:10 for NE states and UT**.
- Aim & Objectives:** Increase India's **domestic production** of edible oils by promoting the cultivation of oil palm trees, **reduce dependence on imports** and enhance farmers' income and livelihood.

### 4. MUSHK BUDJI RICE

In a study recently published in **Nature Scientific Reports** mentioned that **altitude and temperature** play an important role in the development of **aroma of Mushk budji Rice**.

#### ABOUT



- It is the **indigenous aromatic rice** variety from **Kashmir**.
- It was on the **verge of extinction** owing to the prevalence of **rice blast disease**, its **low yield, and lack of profitability**. But a program launched in 2007 by **SKUAST** scientists saw the crop make a slow comeback.
- Mushk budji Rice of Anantnag District in Jammu and Kashmir received the **Geographical Indication Tag** in 2023.

### 1. EARLY JACARANDA BLOOM

Early blooming of the **Jacaranda trees in Mexico** has sparked the debate about **climate change**.

#### ABOUT



- Jacaranda trees are known for their stunning **purple flowers** and are **native to South America**, particularly **Argentina and Brazil**.
- They are also found in other parts of the world, including **Australia**, where they are commonly planted as **ornamental trees**.
- These trees are prized for their vibrant **display of flowers**, which typically bloom in spring or early summer, depending on the region.

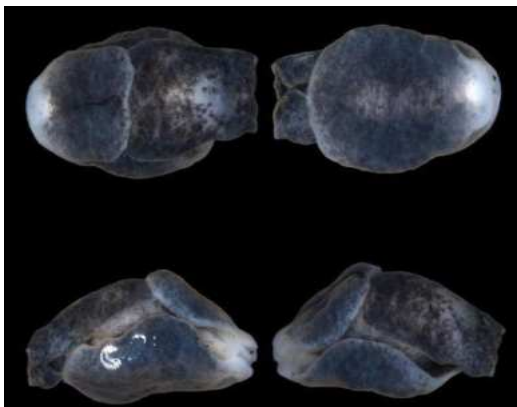
- Jacarandas are **deciduous trees**, meaning they **shed their leaves annually**, typically before flowering.
- Jacaranda trees prefer **warm climates and well-drained soil**. They are relatively **drought-tolerant** once established and can **thrive in full sun**.

### 2. SEA SLUG

The **Zoological Survey of India** named a new marine species of **head-shield sea slug** after President of India Droupadi Murmu.

#### SEA SLUG



- **Distribution:** They can be found from the **shallow intertidal to the deep sea** and from the polar regions to the tropics.
- **Habitat:** Sea slugs are a **group of molluscs** that live primarily in **marine habitats** and are slug-like.
- Sea slugs are **hermaphroditic**, meaning they possess both **male and female reproductive organs**. They can reproduce through both **sexual and asexual means**.
- So far, 18 species have been discovered across the globe, including **one tropical species from the Gulf of Thailand**.

### 3. PM SURYA GHAR MUFT BIJLI YOJANA

Recently, the Union Cabinet approved PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana to provide **300 units of free electricity to 1 crore families**.

## ABOUT THE PM SURYA GHAR MUFT BIJLI YOJANA



- It aims to light up 1 crore households by providing up to 300 units of **free electricity every month**, marking a significant step towards **sustainable development and people's wellbeing**.
- It was launched with an investment of over **Rs. 75,000 crores**.

## IMPLEMENTATION

- Under this scheme, households will be provided with a **subsidy to install solar panels** on their roofs.
- Households can register themselves on the PM Surya Ghar website (<https://pmsuryaghar.gov.in>) to avail benefits under the scheme.

### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

- The **subsidy** will cover up to 40% of the cost of the solar panels. The remaining costs have to be borne by the **aspirant consumer**.
- The Centre will fund **60% of the cost for installing 2 kW (kilowatt) systems** and **40% of the cost for systems from 2-3 kW capacity**.
- Systems of **higher wattage** will not be eligible for **Central subsidy**.
- At current benchmark prices, this will mean ₹30,000 subsidy for 1 kW system, ₹60,000 for 2 kW systems and ₹78,000 for 3 kW systems or higher.

### OTHER FEATURES OF THE SCHEME

- A **Model Solar Village** will be developed in each district of the country to act as a role model for adoption of rooftop solar in rural areas.
- **Urban Local Bodies and Panchayati Raj Institutions** shall also benefit from incentives for promoting RTS installations in their areas.
- The scheme provides a component for **payment security** for **renewable energy service company (RESCO)** based models as well as a fund for innovative projects in RTS.

It is estimated that the scheme will create around 17 lakh direct jobs in manufacturing, logistics, supply chain, sales, installation and other services

### Benefits

It includes free electricity for households, reduced electricity costs for the government, increased use of renewable energy, and reduced carbon emissions

It is a significant step towards promoting the use of renewable energy in India

The **Federal Parliament of Belgium** has made history by becoming the first country in the European Continent to recognise 'ecocide' as a **national as well as an international crime**.

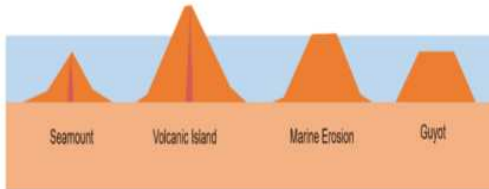
The law targets individuals in positions of decision-making power and corporations, aiming to prevent and **punish severe environmental degradation** such as extensive oil spills.

## GEOGRAPHY

### 1. SEAMOUNTS

Schmidt Ocean Institute has discovered Four new Seamount while traveling from **Costa Rica to Chile**.

#### SEAMOUNT



- A seamount is an **underwater mountain with steep sides** rising from the seafloor.
- When volcanoes form on the seafloor, they build up over time as they **erupt volcanic lava that cools to become basalt**.
- If a volcano grows in height and volume enough to reach the ocean's surface, it becomes a volcanic island.

#### Guyot

When a seamount breaches the sea surface, waves and other sub-aerial processes (wind, rainfall, weathering) will cause erosion of the volcano

Over time, these processes will erode the flanks and top of the seamount/ island, eventually forming a flat shelf to form a guyot

- The mountains discovered range in size from around 1,591 meters high to around 2,681 meters.

## 2. SHANKARACHARYA HILL

Prime Minister of India recently paid **obeisance to Shankaracharya Hill** during his visit to **Jammu and Kashmir**.

### ABOUT SHANKARACHARYA HILLS



- The ancient Shankaracharya Temple, constructed with **grey stones**, stands on Shankaracharya Hill, on the **Zabarwan Range in Srinagar**, Jammu and Kashmir.
- Initially known as **Takht-i-Sulaiman**, which means **Throne of Solomon**, it was later renamed after a saint who preached enlightenment here in AD 750.

- The temple, dedicated to **Lord Shiva**, is situated at a height of 1000 feet and can be reached in 10-15 minutes via stairs.
- This ancient temple holds significance as the place where the renowned **seer Adi Shakaracharya attained enlightenment**.

## 3. DARIEN GAP

Darien Gap had become a **major route for the illegal migration to US**.

### DARIEN GAP



- The Darien Gap is a **stretch of densely forested jungle** across **northern Colombia** located in **South America** and **southern Panama** located in North America.
- Roughly 60 miles (97 kilometres) across, the terrain is **muddy, wet and unstable**.

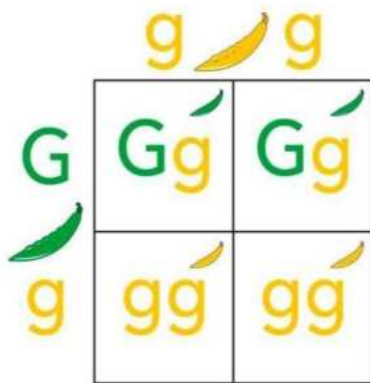

#### ABOUT



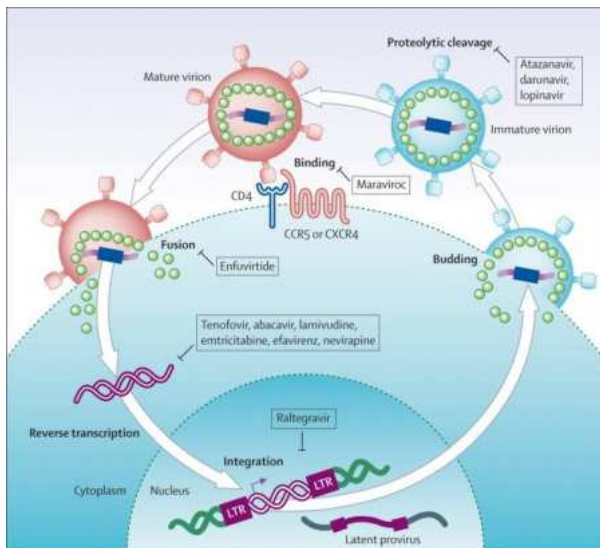
- The Punnett Square is named after **British geneticist Reginald Punnett**.
- Along the **top and side** of the grid, the possible genetic traits of **one parent on one side** and the **other parent on the other side** are listed. Then these squares are filled by **combining the traits** from each parent.
- Each square effectively represents a possible combination of **traits that their offspring could inherit**. It's a simple way to **visualize the probabilities** of different traits showing up in the offspring.
- A Punnett Square is a useful tool that helps **predict the variations and probabilities** resulting from cross-breeding.

### 2. ANTIRETROVIRAL THERAPY (ART) INITIATIVE

Twenty years of Free Antiretroviral Therapy (ART) initiative have been completed recently.

#### ABOUT ANTIRETROVIRAL THERAPY (ART) INITIATIVE



- It was on April 1, 2004 for **Persons living with HIV (PLHIV)**.
- It is the treatment of people infected with **human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)** using anti-HIV drugs.
- The standard treatment consists of a combination of drugs (often called "**highly active antiretroviral therapy**" or **HAART**) that suppress HIV replication.
- **Rationale behind the initiative:** At the emergence of HIV/AIDS in the early 1980s, the disease was considered a **death sentence** and was met with a lot of **fear, stigma and discrimination**. Access to many medicines including the first antiretroviral drug, **AZT (zidovudine)**, remained limited for most of the world's population except in some high-income countries.

**Impact:** In 2023, the prevalence of HIV in 15-49 years has come down to 0.20 (confidence interval 0.17%-0.25%) and the burden of disease in terms of estimated **PLHIV has been coming down to 2.4 million**. India's share in PLHIV globally had come down to **6.3% (from around 10% two decades ago)**. The annual new HIV infections in India have **declined by 48%** against the global average of 31% (the baseline year of 2010).

**OTHER RELATED INITIATIVES**

In 2021, India adopted a policy of rapid ART initiation in which a person was started on ART within seven days of HIV diagnosis, and in some cases, even the same day

The ongoing and fifth phase of India's National AIDS Control program (NACP) aims to (by 2025) reduce the annual new HIV infections by 80%, reduce AIDS-related mortalities by 80% and eliminate vertical transmission of HIV and syphilis

**Other Initiatives**

There were many complementary initiatives which have contributed to halting the HIV epidemic

These include the provision of free diagnostic facilities; attention on prevention of parent to child transmission of HIV (PPTCT) services

Dolutegravir (DTG), a new drug with superior virological efficacy and minimal adverse effects was introduced in 2020

**3. CARBON FIBRE**

India is planning to manufacture carbon fibre for use in **aerospace, civil engineering and defence** as an **alternative to metal**.

**ABOUT CARBON FIBRE**



- Carbon fiber is made by **heating a carbon-containing material**, such as **polyacrylonitrile (PAN), rayon, or pitch**, to a very high temperature in an inert atmosphere.
- The main features include the **high modulus** and specific **tensile strength** calculated by the excellence of the **graphite crystallites**.


<b>Applications</b>	Carbon fiber composites are <b>very strong and lightweight</b> , and they are also <b>corrosion-resistant</b> and have a <b>good electrical conductivity</b> . This makes them ideal for use in a variety of applications, including: <b>Aircraft manufacturing, Automotive manufacturing, Sports equipment, and Medical devices</b> .
<b>Status in India</b>	Currently, India <b>does not produce any carbon fibre</b> , relying entirely on imports from countries such as the <b>US, France, Japan and Germany</b> .

## ECONOMY

### 1. SUPREME COURT'S BAN ON PATANJALI ADS

Recently, the Supreme Court of India issued the **contempt notice** and passed an **interim order** imposing a ban on advertisements of Patanjali Ayurved's medicines.

Earlier, the **Central Consumer Protection Authority** has also issued guidelines to curb misleading advertising in the coaching field.

### CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT, 2019

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The <b>Act came into force in July 2020 and it will empower consumers and help them in protecting</b> their rights through its various notified <b>rules and provisions</b>.</li> </ul>	

### CENTRAL CONSUMER PROTECTION AUTHORITY

- Section 10 of the Consumer Protection Act, 2019 establishes the Central Consumer Protection Authority which seeks to **promote, protect and enforce the rights** of consumers as a class.
- Powers & Functions of CCPA:** It is empowered to:
  - conduct investigations into violation of **consumer rights and institute complaints / prosecution**
  - order recall of **unsafe goods and services**
  - order discontinuation of **unfair trade practices and misleading advertisements**
  - impose penalties on **manufacturers/endorsers/publishers** of misleading advertisements.

#### About

The Allegations: The Indian Medical Association (IMA) had accused Patanjali of carrying out a smear campaign against modern medicine and vaccination

The company was also alleged to have continued issuing advertisements about the efficacy of its medicines, which is prohibited under the Drugs and Magic Remedies (Objectionable Advertisements) Act of 1954 and the Consumer Protection Act, 2019

### IMPACTS

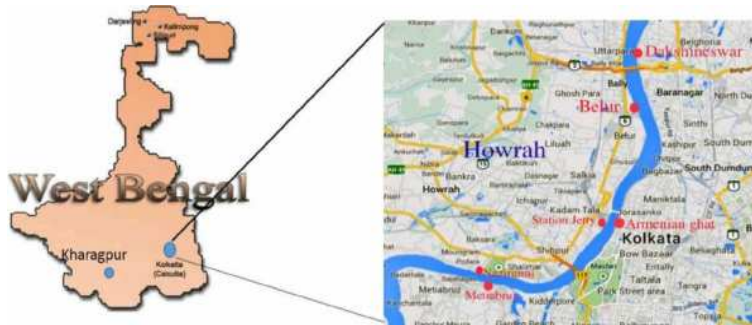
- It serves as a reminder that **misleading claims about medicinal products** are not only **unethical but also illegal**.
- It highlights the role of regulatory bodies and the judiciary in ensuring that companies adhere to **advertising laws and regulations**.

- The metro network in India is currently the third biggest in the world after the **USA and China**.

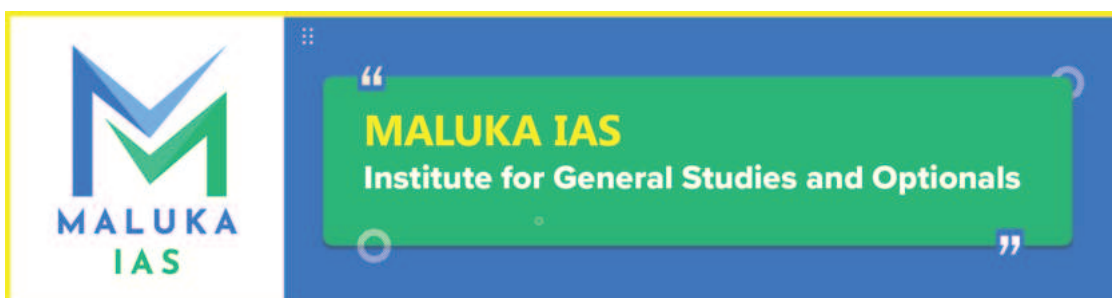

- It is also known as the '**Coffee Club**' that comprises 12 member countries (**Argentina, Canada, Colombia, Costa Rica, Italy, Malta, Mexico, Pakistan, the Republic of Korea, San Marino, Spain, and Turkiye**) and 2 observers (**China and Indonesia**).
- It primarily aims to counter bids for permanent seats in the United Nations Security Council by **G4 nations – India, Brazil, Germany, and Japan**.

### THE UfC MODEL AND ITS CRITICISM

### 1. PB-SHABD

Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting launched the **Prasar Bharti - Shared Audio Visuals for Broadcast and Dissemination (PB-SHABD)**, a news-sharing service from Prasar Bharati, aimed at transforming **news dissemination** in India.

#### ABOUT



- PB-SHABD will serve as **a single-point source of news content** for smaller news organizations **lacking extensive networks**.
- SHABD service is offered **free for the first year**, providing news stories in major **Indian languages** across fifty categories.
- The minister highlighted the revamped platforms for **Doordarshan News and Akashvani News**, and updated News on the Air mobile app, emphasizing their role in democratizing **access to news** and fostering collaboration within the media industry.
- Prasar Bharati is India's largest public broadcasting agency. It is a **statutory autonomous body** set up by the Prasar Bharati Act, 1997.

- The Prasar Bharati Corporation's main objective is to provide autonomy to **Doordarshan and Akashvani** to **"educate and entertain the public."**

### 2. DISTRICT ELECTION MANAGEMENT PLAN

As per the Election Commission of India, the **district election management plan (DEMP)** is to be prepared at least **six months before the tentative poll day**.

#### ABOUT



- DEMP is a comprehensive document that uses statistics and analysis to ensure the **smooth conduct of elections**.
- Executing the DEMP requires a collaborative effort involving **election officials, administrative authorities, law enforcement agencies** etc. Regular interactions with political parties and media are also planned to brief them on electoral rules.
- Material management is a crucial component of the DEMP involving procuring **61 essential items, including indelible ink, seals, stamps, stationary and statutory forms**.
- These items are categorized based on the level at which they are to be procured (**State/U.T. or district level**), with timelines ranging from **two-to-three weeks to four months** before the election.

### 4. CINEMATOGRAPH (CERTIFICATION) RULES, 2024

The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has introduced the Cinematograph (Certification) Rules, 2024, replacing the outdated 1983 rules, in accordance with the Cinematograph (Amendment) Act, 2023. The Cinematograph (Amendment) Act of 2023 amended the Cinematograph Act of 1952, which governs the **certification, exhibition, and censorship of films in India**.

### FILM INDUSTRY IN INDIA

Video streaming services, including OTT (over-the-top) platforms, became very popular in India during the pandemic and lockdowns when people were confined to their homes

The online video market in India has a mix of global and local players competing for over 400 million users

The jobs created by the television and film industry across the country were estimated to be 4.12 million in the financial year 2022, up from about 2.36 million jobs in the financial year 2017

#### Film Industry

It is the largest in the world in terms of the number of films produced and the most globalised industry in the world producing more than 3,000 films annually in more than 40 languages

The three largest film industries in India are Hindi, Telugu, and Tamil

Known for its vibrant and diverse cinema, it had a market size of over 172 billion Indian rupees in the year 2022. This figure indicates a recovery trajectory, although the industry is still navigating the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic and the rapid growth of video over-the-top (OTT) culture

### CENTRAL BOARD OF FILM CERTIFICATION (CBFC)

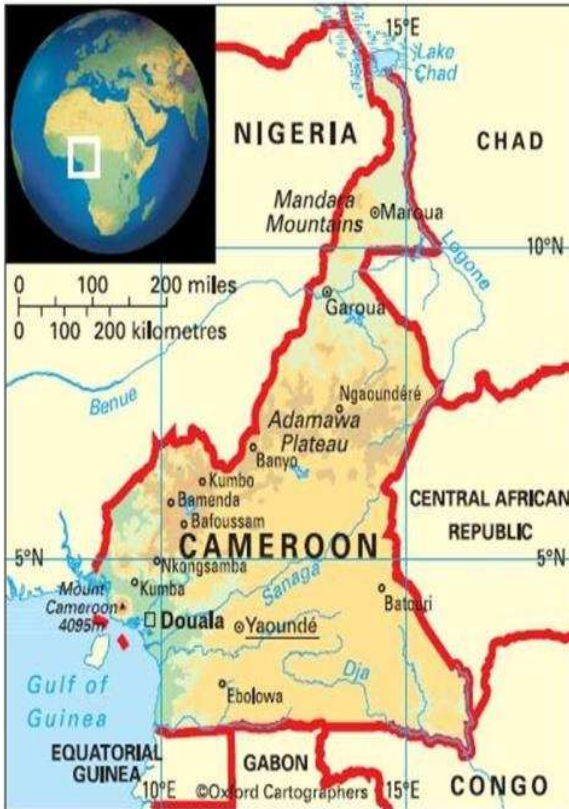


## SOCIAL JUSTICE

### 1. YAOUNDE DECLARATION

Recently, the Yaoundé Declaration marked a significant milestone in the **fight against malaria**, as health ministers from 11 African countries pledged to end malaria deaths.

#### ABOUT



- The total number of malaria cases globally increased **from 233 million in 2019 to 249 million** in 2022.
- Africa witnessed a significant rise in malaria cases during this period, reaching 233 million cases. Africa accounts for 94% of global malaria cases and 95% of malaria-related deaths.
- While progress against malaria has **stagnated in the WHO Africa region**, the 11 African countries involved in the Yaoundé conference account for over 70% of the global malaria burden.
- The declaration aims to **strengthen health infrastructure, expand personnel capacity, and enhance program implementation**. They also seek to foster **partnerships for funding, research, and innovation**.
- Despite the declaration, experts highlight the need for concrete action on the ground. The African Union's goal to control and eliminate malaria by 2030 faces significant financial gaps, with USD 1.5 billion needed to sustain basic malaria services and **additional funds required for climate adaptation** in the health sector.

- It is transmitted by **infected ticks of the genus Ixodes**.
- **Erythema migrans rash** is the most characteristic symptom and others are **headache, fatigue, and muscle aches**.
- It is mostly common in the **US, Europe** & some parts of **Asia**.

### 3. WHO CORONAVIRUS NETWORK (COVINET)

Recently, the World Health Organization (WHO) launched the 'CoViNet' — a global laboratory to monitor **emerging coronaviruses**.

#### ABOUT THE CoViNet



- CoViNet is a **network of global laboratories** with expertise in **human, animal, and environmental coronavirus surveillance**.
  - The network currently includes **36 laboratories from 21 countries in all 6 WHO regions**.
  - It expands on the WHO COVID-19 reference laboratory network established during the early days of the pandemic.
  - Initially, the lab network was focused on **SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19**.
- However, the network will now address a broader range of coronaviruses, including **MERS-CoV and potential new coronaviruses**.

#### THE OBJECTIVES OF CoViNet

It aims to facilitate and coordinate global expertise and capacities for early and accurate detection, monitoring, and assessment of SARS-CoV-2, MERS-CoV, and novel coronaviruses of public health importance

#### Objectives

It aims to monitor the global circulation and evolution of these viruses, recognizing the need for a 'One Health' approach

It aims to provide timely risk assessment for these viruses to inform WHO policy related to a range of public health and medical countermeasures

### 4. ASBESTOS

Recently, the **United States' Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)** announced a **comprehensive ban on all forms of the deadly carcinogen asbestos**.

#### ABOUT THE ASBESTOS



- It is a naturally occurring mineral, has been widely used in various industries **due to its heat and chemical resistance, tensile strength, and insulating properties**.
- However, it is a **known carcinogen**, and exposure to it can lead to serious health issues, including **lung cancer, mesothelioma, and asbestosis**, and it is linked to more than 40,000 deaths in the US each year.

#### THE GLOBAL SCENARIO

- Currently, more than 65 countries, including the **US**, have imposed **bans or severe restrictions** on its use.
- It continues to be **used in many other countries**, including **India**.

## INTERNATIONAL SECURITY

### 1. JUICE JACKING

Recently, the **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)** issued a warning against **charging mobile phones using public ports**.

#### ABOUT THE JUICE JACKING



- It is a type of cyberattack where **hackers tamper with public USB charging ports**, infecting them with malware or making hardware changes that allow them to **steal data from devices** connected to them.
- Most attacks target both **Android and iOS mobile devices**, with older devices being particularly vulnerable due to their outdated software.

#### THE THREAT

When users connect their devices to compromised USB ports, hackers use the connection to hack into mobile devices and steal personal data like **email, SMS, and saved passwords** or **deliver malware** by gaining access to the phones.

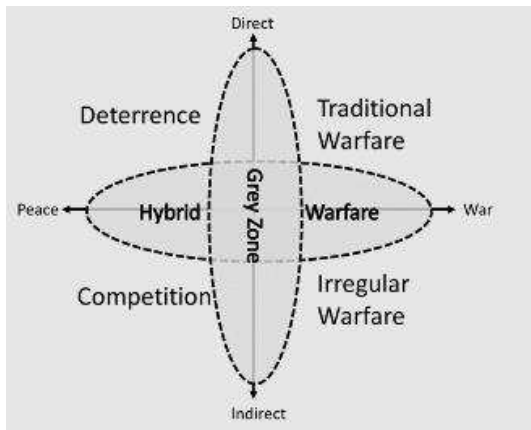

### 3. GREY ZONE WARFARE

In the 2024 **Raisina Dialogue**, India's Chief of Defence Staff mentioned that grey zone warfare is the **latest informal warfare**.

#### ABOUT



- Grey zone warfare generally means a **middle, unclear space** that exists between **direct conflict and peace in international relations**.
- It includes criminal economic activities, influence operations, and cyberattacks to **mercenary operations, assassinations, disinformation campaigns, debt traps and economic sanctions**.
- Reasons for engaging in such tactics include the **projection of strength**, and to **normalize disputed territorial claims** by repeatedly marking a presence in those regions.

#### SOME EXAMPLES OF GREY ZONE WARFARE

Taiwan has complained for four years of stepped-up Chinese military action, such as fighters regularly flying over the strait as part of a 'grey zone' strategy to wear down Taiwan with activities that stop short of a full-blown conflict

#### Examples

The Chinese military's presence in the South China Sea

The US has also engaged in similar tactics. These include its economic sanctions against China and imposition of duties on Chinese imports to the US

- It utilizes **passive RF sensor technology** to **eliminate false alarms**, and its sensor and jammer combination meets stringent military standard specifications for **durability and reliability**.
- The system's core sensor, built around Artificial Intelligence and computer vision algorithms, enables **precise identification, classification and location identification of drones**.

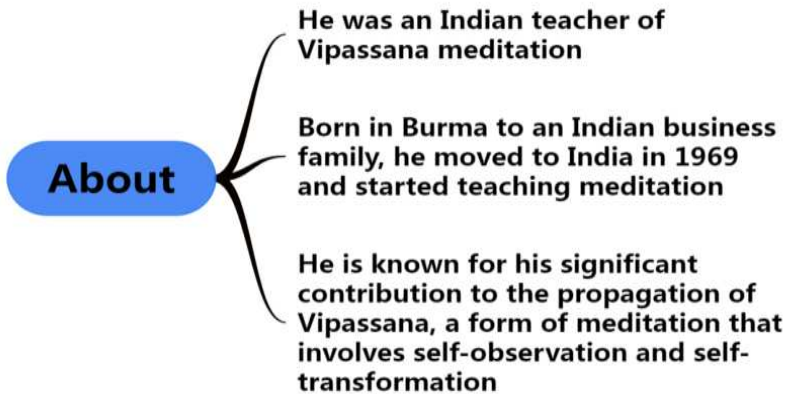
