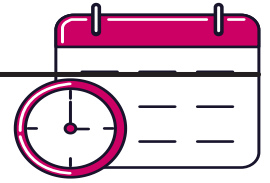

Hence total Theoretical Questions = 13 + 6 Case studies (Total Including sub parts = 19 Ques.)

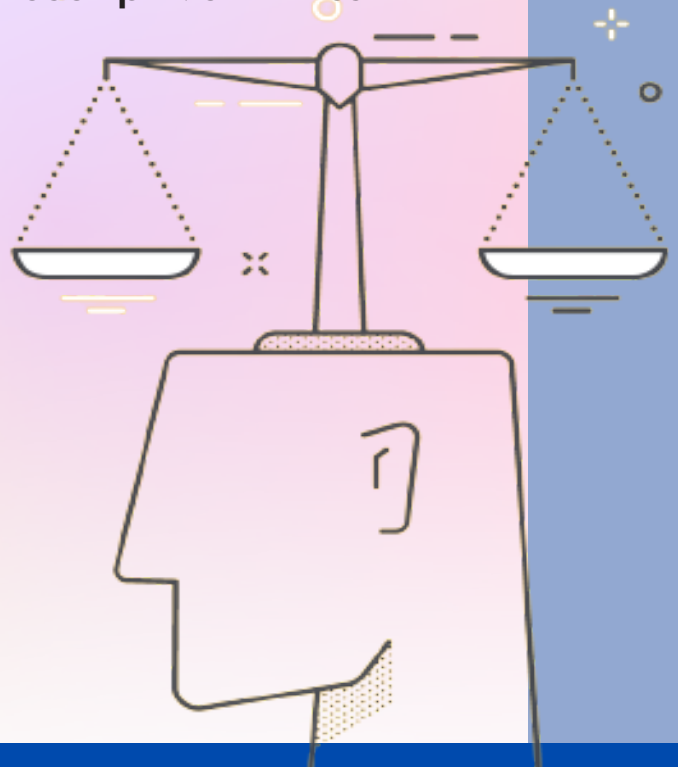

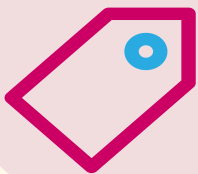
