



PM Modi to Inaugurate BAPS Temple in UAE

The BAPS temple, the first Hindu temple in the UAE, will be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi during his two-day visit to UAE. The temple's external facade uses pink sandstone from Rajasthan, while the interior features Italian marbles. This marks a significant moment for the Hindu community in UAE and strengthens the bilateral ties between the two countries.



What is BAPS?

1 Global Presence

BAPS has a network of around 1,550 temples across the world, including prominent ones in New Delhi, London, and Toronto. It also runs 3,850 centers and 17,000 weekly assemblies globally.

2 Community Vision

The vision for the Hindu temple in Abu Dhabi was envisioned by Pramukh Swami Maharaj to bring countries, communities, and cultures together, meeting the needs of the local Indian community.





Features of the Temple

Architectural Design

The Abu Dhabi temple is a traditional stone Hindu temple with seven shikhars, built in the traditional Nagar style. The front panel depicts universal values, stories of harmony, and Hindu spiritual leaders.

Significance

The temple complex, spread over 27 acres, was gifted by Sheikh Mohammed Bin Zayed Al Nahyan, the President of the UAE, and features a Wall of Harmony and two central domes, emphasizing human coexistence.

Construction

More than Rs 700 crore was spent on the temple's construction, with 20,000 tonnes of stones and marble shipped in 700 containers for the temple.



Key Architectural Features


1 Recognition

The temple was judged the Best

2 Unique Elements

The temple features 96 bells and gaumukhs, nano tiles for visitor comfort, and a special 'Pillar of pillars' with around 1,400 small pillars carved into it.


Indian Deities
