Prime Time: Government and Opposition

The Prime Minister's parliamentary interventions are keenly watched for insights into the government's priorities and responses to Opposition criticisms. This week, Narendra Modi spoke extensively in both Houses, but his speeches largely sidestepped critical national issues.

Key developments like the inhumane deportation of Indian citizens by the U.S., the stampede at the Maha Kumbh, and advancements in Artificial Intelligence received little substantive acknowledgment. Instead, Mr. Modi's speeches relied heavily on campaign slogans, minimal engagement with the Opposition, and repeated attacks on past governments, particularly the Congress.







Sidestepping National Issues

Deportation of Indian Citizens

The inhumane way in which Indian deportees were flown back by the United States received little to no substantive acknowledgment.

Stampede at Maha Kumbh

The stampede at the Maha Kumbh in Prayagraj, a significant event with tragic consequences, was largely ignored in the Prime Minister's address.

Attacks on Past Governments






