# The Debate: Sovereignty vs. Open Source

## **Pranesh Prakash: Focus on Application**

**India should work on foundation models, but not for sovereignty. It's crucial to have experts who can build and apply AI. Open source models eliminate national security concerns and sanctions, as Indians can modify existing code.**

## **Tanuj Bhojwani: Pride and Returns**

**Sovereignty is a factor, but even with a local model, GPUs are needed. India lacks contracts with chip manufacturers. The key is to ensure returns on investment, balancing pride with financial practicality.**

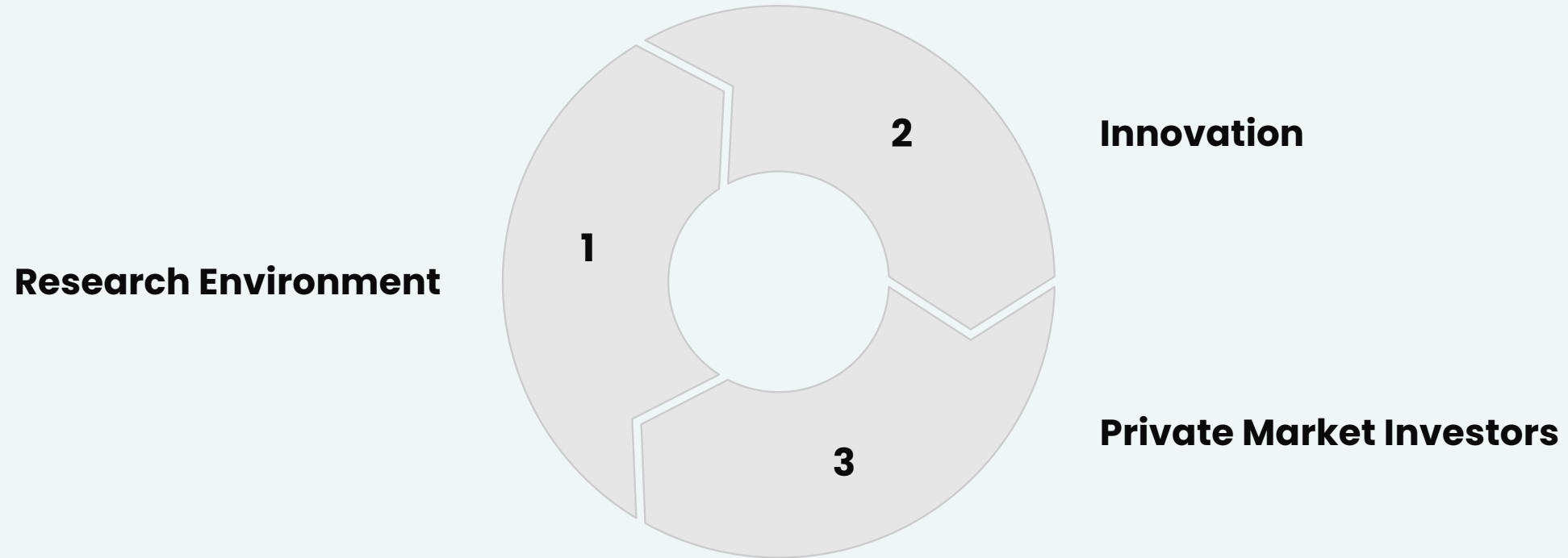

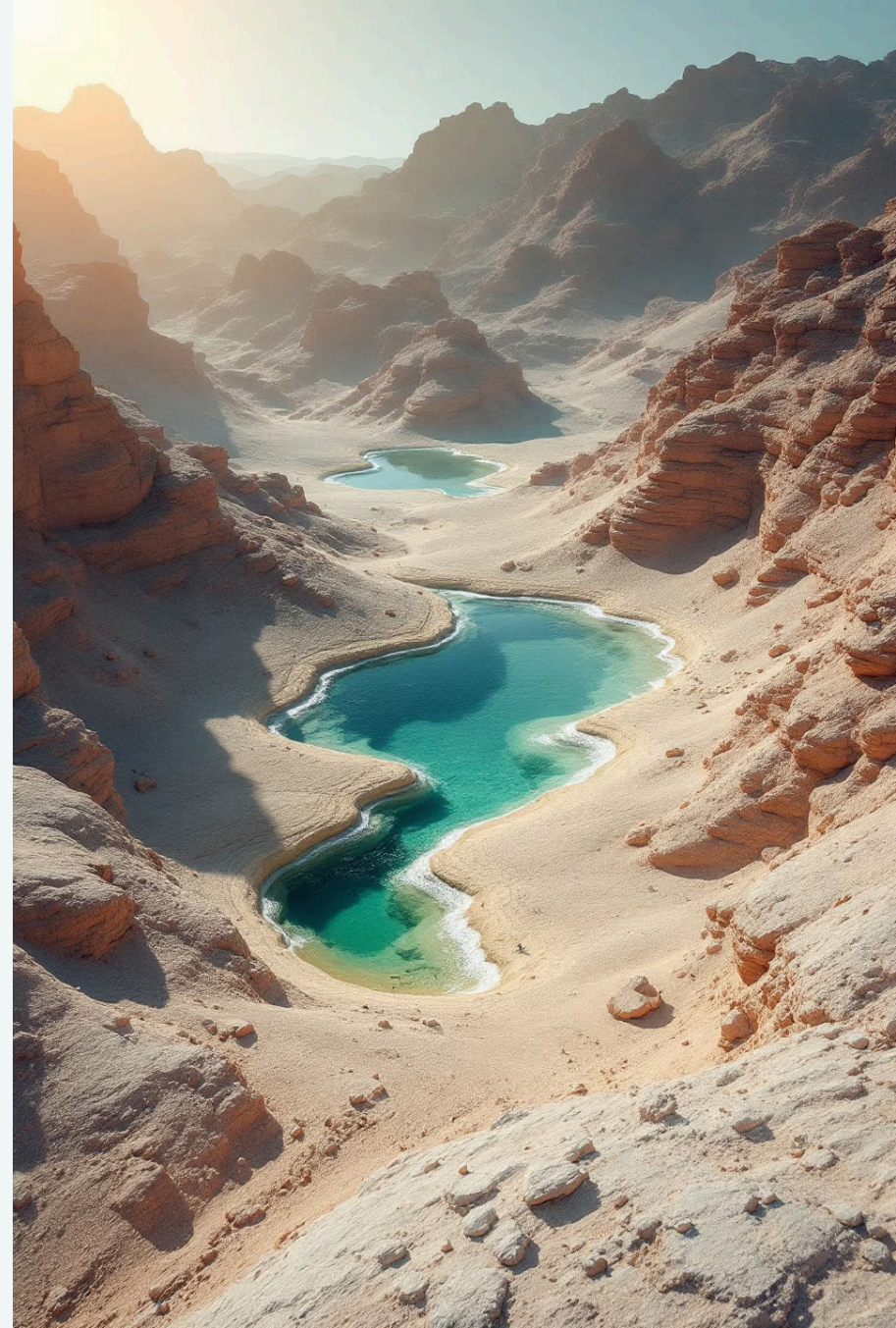
## **Captive GPUs**
