Live Tracking and Statistics

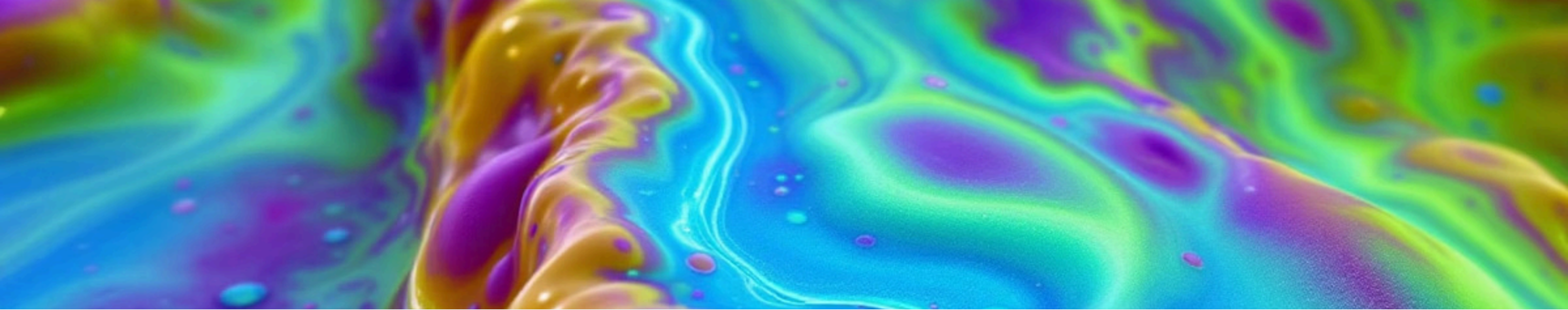
Analysis of speed, endurance and mobility patterns

Specialized Race Track Design



Based on the Female Reproductive System

A design that mimics the natural environment



Microfluidics Technology

Based on the principles of fluid flow dynamics



Chemical Signals

Chemicals that naturally attract sperm

This race track is made of micro-compatible materials and includes natural curves and pathways. Its design is modeled after the actual female reproductive system, allowing for the simulation of the sperm's natural journey.

Participants and Ethical Considerations

Voluntary Sperm Samples

Samples will be voluntarily obtained from healthy adult males. All samples will remain anonymous and the identity of any participant will not be made public.

Participation of Prominent Individuals

Samples from some prominent athletes and personalities may also be included, but their identities will be kept confidential. All samples will be collected with their consent.

Bioethics Committee Oversight

The entire event is being monitored by a bioethics committee. After the event, all sperm cells will be destroyed and no fertilization will be performed.

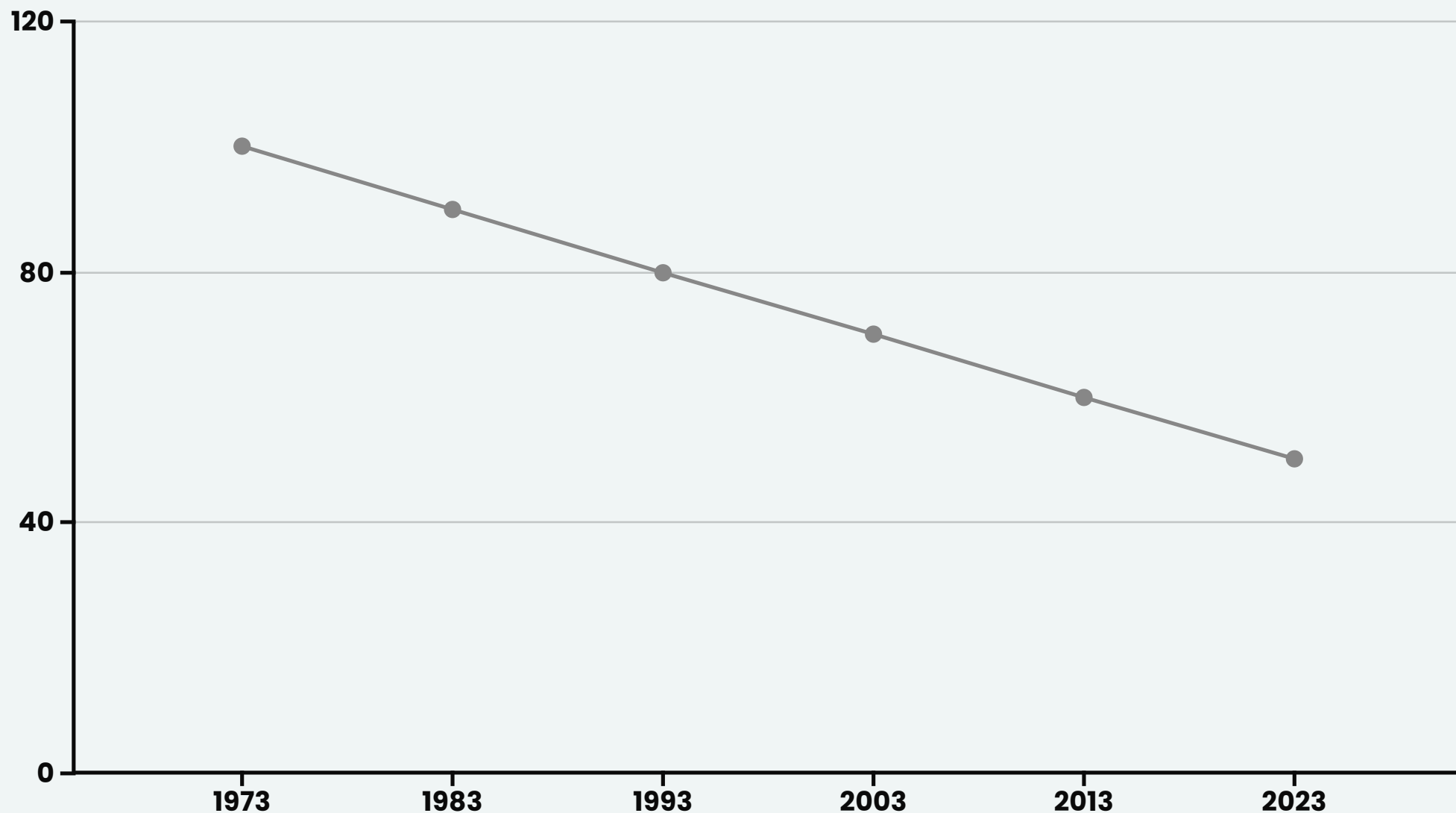

Crisis in Male Fertility



Since 1973, there has been a nearly 50% decline in global male fertility rates. This is due to various factors such as stress, poor diet, obesity, smoking, alcohol consumption, and pollution.

Last year, there was also discussion about the potential extinction of the Y chromosome. The number of genes in the Y chromosome has decreased from thousands to only 50–60 over thousands of years.

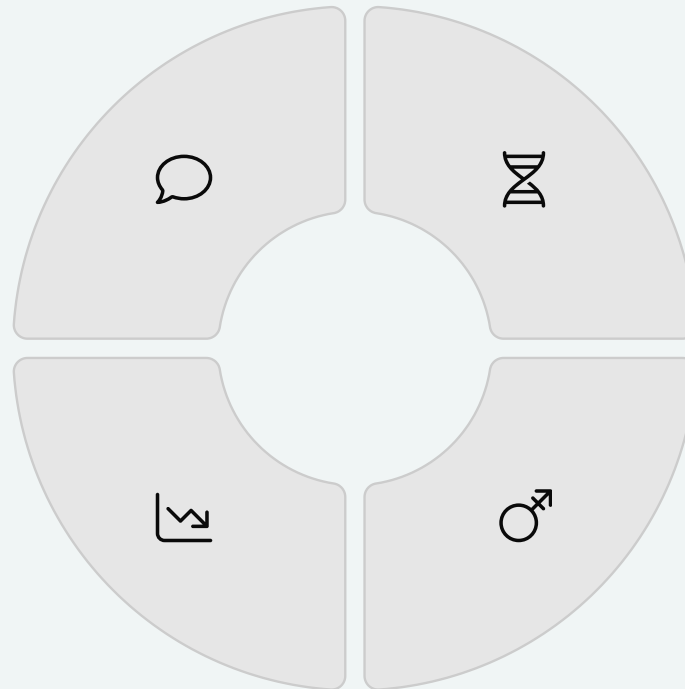
Importance and Concerns of the Y Chromosome

Characteristics of the Y Chromosome

Males have both X and Y chromosomes, while females have two X chromosomes

Gradual Decline

The number of genes in the Y chromosome has declined significantly over thousands of years



Lack of Genes

The Y chromosome has only 50-60 genes left, while the X chromosome has thousands of genes

Role in Male Development

The SRY gene is responsible for the development of male characteristics

Social Stigma and Awareness



Lack of Discussion

Men rarely discuss issues related to their reproductive capacity



Social Stigma

Male infertility is often associated with a lack of masculinity



Raising Awareness

Such events can help reduce social stigma

Especially in countries like India, it is often taboo for men to discuss reproductive health issues. Such events can encourage open discussion on these issues and convey the message that it is a common health concern that should be addressed without shame.

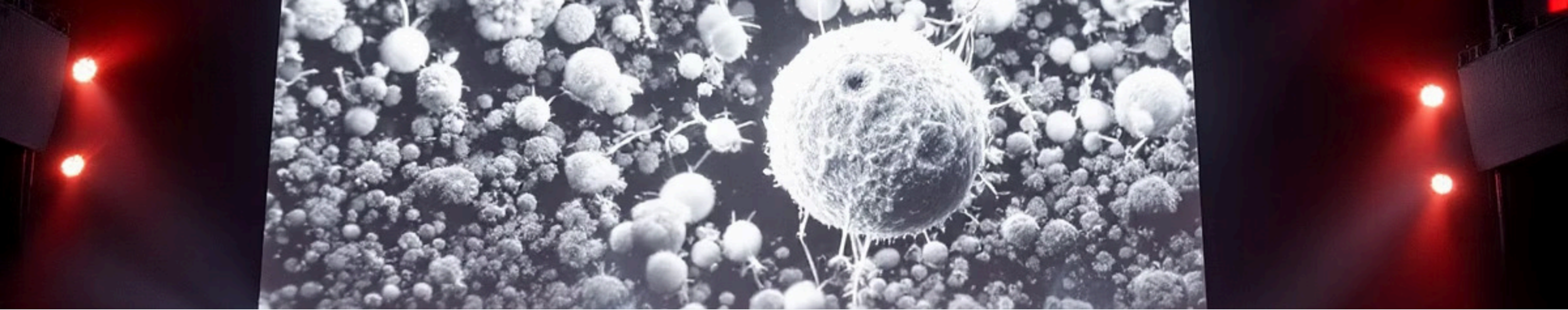

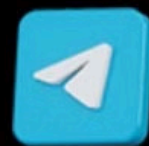
